MENTOR PLATFORM TRAINING

We started 2024 with a three-day Mentor Platform Training program for seven mentors in Bulawayo. Some of the participants were new members of the EAGLE family who are initiating learnings groups in the Disciple Nations Churches.

Each training day started with discipleship sessions, to emphasise the importance of spending time with Jesus. These were followed by practical sessions that covered learner platform registration, accessing the grade book, and managing student accounts, with plenty of opportunity for the mentors to practise the skills they were learning.

One of the primary objectives of this workshop was to equip the mentors with the skills to use the EAGLE platform efficiently. As well as this, they have been given ideas on fun ways to make sure kids feel seen, heard and motivated in their learning groups.

NEW EAGLE NESTS

In December of last year, we received a shipment of strategic components needed to assemble more EAGLE NESTs. This month, our team has had an exciting time assembling the NESTs!

Each NEST contains 30 tablets and a portable solar unit, ensuring that the NESTs remain charged and children can learn without interruption, even if there is no electricity in their area.

EAGLE NESTs will be deployed to urban and peri-urban learning groups. One learning group has begun as a fantastic initiative to provide quality education to children living in a squatter camp. The children have registered and are eagerly waiting to begin their learning journey! Our focus remains on providing excellent learning experiences to children like this.
