We collaborated with Keller to organize a workshop for teachers from Hope and Induna schools, focused on the theme of "Highway to learning". During the workshop, teachers were educated on the significance of building a connection with their students before starting daily activities and incorporating energizing activities. The aim is to help teachers create a stress-free classroom environment for their learners.

The workshop ran throughout the month of June and teachers learned that when they meet children from different backgrounds and homes, some are quite hard to handle in class but they were taught how to handle the children accordingly. The teachers in the workshop impact over four hundred learners. The training was split into 6 sessions and each session had interactive videos, icebreakers and in person discussions

Overall, our participation in the Ebenezer annual graduation allowed us to expand our network,

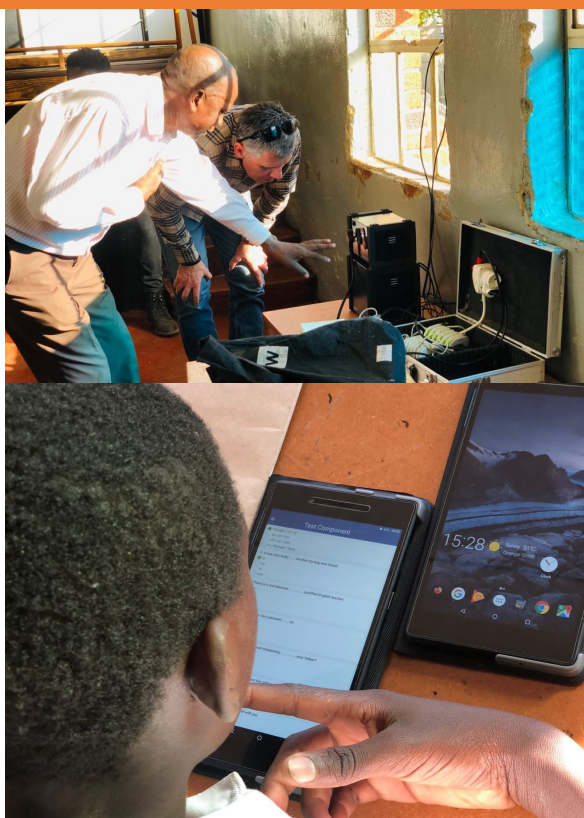
showcase our Nests and connect with individuals who are passionate about education and supporting the growth and development of children in Zimbabwe.
